A Proclamation for "Boys and Girls Week"

WHEREAS, the week of April 29 to May 6, 1950, has been selected as Boys and Girls Week throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, this observance is the 30th annual celebration of Boys and Girls Week; and

WHEREAS, the theme of the week is "Youth's Responsibilities" and the program is designed to focus public attention upon the interests, activities, potentialities and problems of youth and to give impetus to character-building activities of youth-serving agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. EDWARDS, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning Saturday, April 29 and ending Saturday, May 6, 1950 as

"Boys and Girls Week"

in this State, and I do hereby call upon the businessmen, civic organizations, churches, schools, youth clubs and organizations, and citizens to cooperate with their Boys and Girls Week Committees in carrying on this worthy program.
