


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby, on request of the Commission and Commissioner of Iron Range Resources & Rehabilitation, constitute and appoint Ralph T. Lilly of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Attorney for said Commissioner and Commission, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. His compensation shall be paid out of the funds appropriated for the purposes provided in Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 298.22, and is hereby fixed at Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) per month for such part time as the Commissioner shall require.


