On March 29th 1913 by resolution order a Special Election to be held on April 8th 1913 for the purpose of submitting to the voters of said village the question of Re incorporating under the general laws of the State of Minnesota.

That on April 8th 1913 Said Special election was duly held. Notice having first been given according to Law and a majority of the votes cast at said special election being in the affirmative.

Now therefore, We do hereby Resolve that the former Charter of the said Village of Avoca be relinquished and the provisions of Chapter Nine Revised Laws of Minnesota of 1905 and Laws amendatory thereof be and is hereby adopted in its place and stead.
