


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby constitute and appoint Phillip M. Stone of Virginia, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to act for the State of Minnesota in the prosecution of the case of State v. Town of Balkan before the District Court of St. Louis County, Minnesota, during the May term of court in that county. Compensation is hereby fixed at \$35.00 per day for time spent on case when not in court and \$50.00 per day when in court, the total sum not to exceed \$100.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand at Saint Paul, Minnesota, this 1st day of May, 1950.


