ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

The Village Council of the Village of Foley do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the village boundaries of the Village of Foley are hereby extended so as to include the following described parcels of land abutting upon said Village, to-wit:

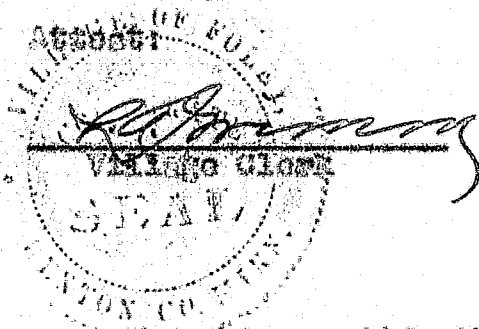
Lot Nine (9) of Park Lots Addition, according to the plat and survey thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, which is of record in the name of Andrew Broeding;

Lots Six (6) and Seven (7) in Block Four (4) of Holdridge Addition to the Village of Foley, according to the plat and survey thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, which is of record in the names of Joseph Brenny and Pauline Brenny, husband and wife, as joint tenants and not as tenants in common;

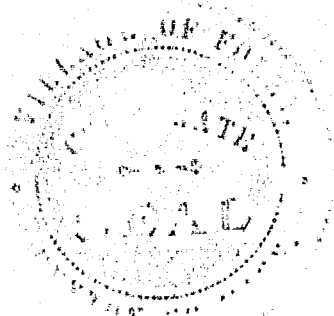
Also that part of Seventh Avenue abutting upon said Lots Six and Seven and lying south of the extended northerly line of said Lot Six in said Block Four in said Holdridge Addition.
