

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION
VILLAGE OF LINCOLN

To: The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka, Minnesota

The undersigned 25 voters, residents of the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your Honorable Board, to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote on the proposition of incorporating such territory as a village, to be known by the name of Village of Lincoln.

The territory proposed to be incorporated is described as follows:

The Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 35, Township 31, Range 23

The South Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 31, Range 23

The Southeast Quarter of Section 36, Township 31, Range 23

Such territory consists of lands which have been partly platted into lots and blocks, which plats have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this state and have been filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Anoka County, Minnesota, the county in which said lands lie, and the unplatted part of such territory adjoins the platted portion and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government. Such territory contains 100 acres of land and has 509 actual residents therein, and 150 buildings thereon, as has been duly ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the 31st day of March, 1950, as appears by the verification hereto; and by a copy of such census attached hereto; each of the undersigned petitioners is a resident of the territory proposed to be incorporated and has been a resident thereof for more than two years preceding the signing hereof.

The South Half of the Northwest Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 35, Township 31, Range 23

The Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 31, Range 23

The petition appearing to be in order, Commissioner Gustafson offered the following resolution and moved its adoption which motion was seconded by Commissioner Johnson:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the above petition be accepted and that an election be held on Friday, the 5th day of May, 1950 at the rear of the Church of Christ Church, located at Lovell and Lexington in Township of Blaine, Anoka County, Minnesota.

between the hours of 8 o'clock A. M. to 8 o'clock P. M. during all of which time the polls will be open.
