A Proclamation for "Foot Health Week Proclamation"

WHEREAS, surveys conducted by the National Association of Chiropractors show that seventy-six per cent of the people in the United States are afflicted with some type of foot ailment, and

WHEREAS, residents of the State of Minnesota realize that the health of both adults and children in this state is our most important asset, and we also are aware that sound foot health is essential to good general health, and

WHEREAS, we know that our responsibilities in this matter are of great importance to the Nation because the future strength and greatness of our people depends to a large extent on the state of their health;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. JOHNSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period from May 20th to May 27th, 1950, as

"FOOT HEALTH WEEK"

and further urge all residents, particularly parents, doctors, teachers, nurses, shoe merchants and repairmen and all others who are interested in cooperating toward improving the foot health of our community be urged to participate in the public education program sponsored by the Minnesota Association of Chiropractors during FOOT HEALTH WEEK.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this seventeenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty and of the state, the ninety-third.
