

A PROCLAMATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA, "YEAR OF YOUTH"

WHEREAS, the University of Minnesota was chartered by the Minnesota Constitutional Convention on January 25, 1851; and

WHEREAS, the University has grown from humble beginnings, with only a single building, and a handful of students, to become one of America's greatest universities, famed for its excellence in research, education, instruction and service; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Minnesota have received innumerable benefits from the University in the prosperity and well-being of the people, through education, research, culture, and cultural leadership; and

WHEREAS, the University of Minnesota entered upon the designated Year of Youth at the beginning of the 1951 academic year on July 1, 1950;

Now therefore, I, Luther W. Youngdahl, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the Academic Year from July 1, 1950, to July 1, 1951, as
