ORDINANCE # 14
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES OF
THE VILLAGE OF YOUNG AMERICA, CRAWLER
COUNTY, MINN.

The Village Council of the Village of Young America do ordain
as follows:

WITNES, the majority of the owners of the following described
tracts or parcels of land situate, lying and being in Crawler County,
Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point of which the center quarter
section east of Section 11, Township 115, Range 26 bears
North 15.00 chains and West 20 chains; thence South 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o
West 257 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a point; thence Southwesterly to a point
on the East line of the West half of the Southeast quarter
of said Section 11, distant 321 feet South of the point of
commencement; thence North on said East line 321 feet to
the place of commencement, situated in the West half of the
Southeast quarter of Section 11, Township 115, Range 26,
containing $\frac{3}{4}$ ths acre more or less, and,

Commencing at a point of which the center Section
east of Section 11, Township 115, Range 26 bears North
15.00 chains and West 20 chains; thence South 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o West
107 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to point of beginning of the within conveyed
tract of land; thence continuing South 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o West 80 ft.,
to a point being Southwesterly corner of the tract of
land conveyed by Frederick Schleichner to Henry and Anna
Schleichner West 66 of book page 333; thence Southwesterly
on Southwesterly line of tract described West book page
333 a distance of 100 feet; thence Northwesterly parallel
to first described line within tract a distance of 60 ft.;
thence Northwesterly 100 feet to the place of beginning, and,

Beginning at a point of which the quarter Section east
of Section 11, Township 115, Range 26 bears North 15.00 chains;
and West 20 chains, running thence South 8.75 chains, thence
North 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o West 6.50 chains; thence North 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o West 6.50 chains,
to the place of beginning, containing 2 acres in the West half
of the Southeast quarter of Section 11, Township 115, Range 26
excepting that part thereof conveyed to Frank Eisenmann, by
deed dated April 15, 1910, recorded in the office of the
Register of Deeds of said County of Crawler in book 27 of deeds,
on page 511, and,

Commencing at a point from which the center quarter Sec-
tion east of Section 11 in Township 115 Range 26 bears North
15.00 chains and West 20 chains, being the Southeast corner
of Jacob Schleichner's two acre piece, thence running North
47 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o West 6.50 chains to Harvard and Young America road, thence
North 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o West along said road 100 feet, thence South 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o
West parallel with South line of said Jacob Schleichner's two
acre piece to the West line of the West one half of Southeast
quarter of Section 11, Township 115, Range 26, thence South
along said West line to the place of beginning, situated in
West half of Southeast quarter of Section 11, Township 115,
Range 26, containing 1 acre of land, more or less, and,

Commencing at a point 1422.5 feet North 37° East from the southwest corner of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 11, Township 115, Range 115, the said point being the center of the Howard-Livingston road, thence North 40° 00' East a distance of 450 feet to a point on the east line of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter aforesaid; thence North on said line a distance of 100 feet to a point; thence North 40° 30' East a distance of 500 feet to a point in the center of the Howard-Livingston road aforesaid, thence North 37° East a distance of 100 feet to place of beginning, containing 1.57 acres of land, and

Commencing at a point in the center of the Howard-Livingston road, the said point being North 37° East a distance of 1422.5 feet from the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 11, Township 115, Range 115; thence North 40° 00' East a distance of 450 feet to a point; thence North 37° 00' East a distance of 100 feet to a point; thence North 40° 00' East a distance of 500 feet to a point in the center of the Howard-Livingston road aforesaid; thence North 37° 00' East a distance of 100 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.75 acres of land, and,

Commencing at a point 1507.2 feet North 37° East from the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 11, Township 115, Range 115, the said point being the center of the Howard-Livingston road, thence North 40° 00' East a distance of 450 feet to a point on the east line of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter aforesaid, thence North on the east line of the aforesaid southwest quarter of the southeast quarter a distance of 100 feet to a point; thence North 40° 00' East a distance of 500 feet to a point in the center of the Howard-Livingston road aforesaid, thence North 37° East a distance of 100 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.66 acres of land, and

beginning at the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 11, Township 115 North of Range 115 East, thence East on Section line 115.75 miles to the intersection of St. Louis, eight-and-a-half; thence North nine and eight-tenths, 37° East 5.00 chains; thence North 7.00 chains; thence North 40° East 5.00 chains to the center of Young's Prairie and Howard Road, thence South 37° East along said road 22.14 chains to place of beginning, containing 22.14 acres, more or less, consisting of 2.41 acres formerly owned by William H. Powell as recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for DeKalb County, Minnesota, in Book 54 of Deeds page 376 on December 5, 1883; also describing the following described piece retained by Frank G. Ivette, viz: Commencing at a point in the center of the Young's Prairie and Howard road, said point being North 37° 00' East a distance of 1422.5 feet from the southeast corner of southwest quarter of Section 11, Township 115 North of Range 115 East, thence South 40° 00' East 500 feet thence North 37° 00' East 100 feet, thence North 40° 00' East 500 feet to a point in the center of the Howard-Livingston road, thence North 37° 00' East 100 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.75 acres of land, more or less;

which said tractors parcels of land abut upon said Village of Young America, are unplattd, and in the aggregate contain less than 200 acres of land, have duly petitioned the Village Council of said Village of Young America to extend the boundary of said Village so as to include said tracts or parcels of land, and whereas said petition was duly granted by said Village of Young America, now, therefore, the boundaries of said Village of Young America are hereby extended so as to include said tracts or parcels of land.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication.
