

BURNQUIST, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 8.06, do hereby, on request of the Minnesota State Agricultural Society, constitute and appoint JAMES B. LUND, of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to act for the Minnesota State Agricultural Society during the 1950 Minnesota State Fair to be held August 26 through September 4, 1950, and for such time as may be necessary to act at that place, either before or after said fair.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand at Saint Paul, Minnesota, this 6th day of July, 1950.




