A Proclamation for "Union Label Week"

WHEREAS, the American Federation of Labor annually sponsors a nation-wide observance of Union Label Week so as to better acquaint the public with the many values symbolized by the Union Label; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota State Federation of Labor will join in carrying out the program planned for this special week; and

WHEREAS, the Union Label has become an American institution recognized throughout the land as a mark of goods produced under sound American principles and practices; and

WHEREAS, the Union Label signifies the product is the work of skilled craftsmen who have joined together for the mutual benefit of all workers and the economic well-being of the nation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, IRVING C. YAWBORTH, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of September 2 to 9, 1950, as

"UNION LABEL WEEK"

in grateful recognition of the importance of the Union Label in our American way of life.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty and of the State, the ninety-third.
