On December 28, 1950, the Village of New London adopted an ordinance annexing adjoining territory to the Village. This was filed in your office as by law required. It was Ordinance No. 38.

In April District Court for Kandiyohi County, declared the ordinance invalid because of not enough signatures on the petition.

Today the Village council passed a repealing ordinance, No. 39, and I am enclosing a copy thereof for filing in your office, with an extra copy for your endorsement.

Immediately after the repealing ordinance, the Council passed a new ordinance, No. 40, annexing practically the same land, excepting only a small tract.

Enclosed is two copies of the new ordinance, No. 40, and ask that you file it, and affix your endorsement on a copy and return to me.

Ordinance No. 40.

An Ordinance to Annex territory to the Village of New London, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of New London, Kandiyohi County, State of Minnesota, do ordain as follows:


Upon the petition of the majority of the property owners involved, and upon the return of the Village Recorder to the effect that he posted notices of hearing on said petition, 30 days prior to said hearing, and upon the determining by the council that said annexation would be for the best interest of said village and of the territory effected, and upon the further determining by the council that the territory is properly conditioned to be subject to Village authority; the said petition is hereby granted and the territory adjoining and abutting the village of New London, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota described as follows:

The Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE of NE) in Section Nine (9) Township one hundred thirty-one (131) Range Thirty-four (34); and the North One-Half of the South one-half (N½ of the S½) of the Northwest Quarter (NW) Section ten (10) Township one- Hundred Twenty-one (121) Range Thirty-four (34), except the East 25 rods of the North 25 rods, seven and one-half feet thereof,

so and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of New London, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.




