PETITION FOR AUNEXATION OF LAND

TO: THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ROTHDAY:

Comes now, Elmer Johnson and Tonetha Johnson, his wife and George Amundson, Morris Amundson and Anton Amundson, all of the owners of the lands hereinafter described, which lands abut upon the Village of Rothsay and do not exceed two hundred acres in area, and respectfully potition the Council that an ordinance be adopted annexing the lands hereinafter described to the Village of Rothsay. That the lands herein described constitute one contiguous tract not exceeding two hundred (200) acres in area, and are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government. That the lands sought to be annexed to the Village of Rothsay are described as follows, to-wit:

That part of Government Lot Three (3) (also described as the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter) of Section Thirty (30), in Township One Mundred thirty-five (135) North, Range Forty-four (hh) West, in Ottertail County, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at an iron monument, located 67 feet East of the Southwest/of the Morthwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 30, thence run North on a line parallel with the West line of said Section 30 and along the East boundary of Trunk Highway No. 52, a distance of 968.3 feet, thence South 89 20' Fast 3hh.7 feet, thence South parallel with the West line of said Section 30 a distance of 968.3 feet to the North line of Juvrud's Addition to Bothsay, thence Wosterly along the Worth line of Juvrud's Addition 3hh.7 feet to the point of beginning, together with all of said Trunk Highway No. 52 lying and being to the Wost of the parcel above described lying within Ottertail County, Einmerota.

That the parcels above described are at the present platted as Sublot Six (6) and Sublot Seven (7) of Government Lot Three (3) in Section 30, Township 135 North, Range Wh West in Ottertail County, Minnesota.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that the Council adopt an ordinance extending the village boundaries of the Village of Notheay to include the lands herein described and the highway herein described.

ORDINANCE NO. 46

An Ordinance extending the village boundaries of the Village of Rothsay in Wilkin and Ottertail Counties, Minnesota, to include within said Village certain lands abutting the same, situated in Ottertail County, Minnesota.

WHEREAS, a potition has been made and filed by a majority of the owners of certain lands situated in Ottortail County, Minnesota, and abutting the Village of Bothsay, praying the Council of said Village to include such lands within such Village, and

WHEREAS, the said lands constitute one contiguous tract or parcel not exceeding two hundred acres in area and are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Covernment, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires by ordinance to so extend the Village boundaries as to include the came in accordance with the statute in such case made and provided,

The Village Council of the Village of Rothsay do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Village boundaries of the Village of Rothsay in the State of Minnesota, are hereby extended so as to include within the Village the following land situated in the county of Ottertail, state of Minnesota, described as follows:

That part of Government Lot Three (3) (also described as the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter) of Section thirty (30), in Township One Hundred thirty-five (135) North, Range Forty-four (hh) West, in Ottertail County, Minnesota, described as follows, te-wit: Beginning at an iron monument located 67 feet East of the Southwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 30, thence run North on a line parallel with the West line of said Section 30 and along the East boundary of Trunk Highway No. 52, a distance of 968.3 feet, thence South 89 20' East 3hh.7 feet, thence South parallel with the West line of said Section 30 a distance of 968.3 feet to the North line of Juvrud's Addition to Rothsay, thence Westerly along the North Line of Juvrud's Addition 3hh.7 feet to the point of beginning, (which lands are now described as Sublots 6 and 7, in Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW) SW2) of Section 30, Township 135, Range hh, according to plat prepared by John Reber, County Surveyor, dated April 2h, 1950) together with all of said Trunk Highway No. 52 lying and being to the West of the parcel above described lying within Ottertail County, Minnesota.

Scotion 2. The lands described above are declared to be part of and included within the Village of Rothsay to all intents and purposes the same as though originally within the incorporated limits of said Village.

Section 3. The Village Recorder of the Village of Rothsay shall file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and a like copy in the office of the Register of Deeds of Ottertail County, Minnesota and Wilkin County, Minnesota.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance and its provisions are hereby repealed.
