ORDINANCE NO. 113

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF A PARCEL OF LAND ABUTTING THE VILLAGE OF BUHL, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The Village council of the Village of Buhl, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That a petition has been filed with the Village Council of Buhl, St. Louis county, Minnesota, requesting that the following described property be annexed to and made a part of the Village of Buhl, St. Louis County, Minnesota:

That portion of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty (20), Township Fifty-Eight (58) North of Range Nineteen (19) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, according to the United States Government survey, described as follows to-wit:

Assuming the east and west quarter line of said section to be due east and west from the east one-sixteenth (1/16) corner on said line, go west Two hundred fifty-five and fourteen-one-hundredths (255.14) feet, thence to the place of beginning, thence South two degrees fifty-eight minutes (2* 58') one hundred eighty three (183) feet, thence west ninety eight (98) feet, thence north two degrees and fifty-eight minutes (2* 58') one hundred eighty three (183) feet, thence east along said quarter line ninety-eight (98) feet to the place of beginning.

to be annexed to Memorial Addition to Buhl, St. Louis County, Minnesota.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and the Village Council have given due consideration to said petition and believe that it is for the best interest of the said Village of Buhl and its inhabitants that said petition be granted.

SECTION 3. It is hereby decreed, affirmed, ratified and adopted that said addition to the Village of Buhl as heretofore described is and shall be a part of and incorporated into the Village of Buhl effective from and after the final passage and adoption of this ordinance,

SECTION 4. Said territory is annexed to the Village of Buhl, St. Louis County, Minnesota, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 413.14 amendatory and supplementary thereto.
