KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, J. A. A. BURNQUIST, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby constitute and appoint WARREN H. STEWART, of St. Cloud, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General for the State of Minnesota, to bring an action to determine adverse claims or to register the title to the real estate which constitutes the campus of the St. Cloud Teachers College, and upon which a new library building is to be erected by the State of Minnesota. Such appointee is to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.

All of the costs and disbursements in such proceeding, including the fees of the attorney hereby appointed, will be paid by the State Teachers College Board.
