R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the petition of Steve Kuryatnik, Joe Rigo, Carl Romano, Andy Phillips and Adolph DuVal was filed with the Village Clerk of the Village of Hibbing, on the 24th day of August, 1949, the said petition bearing date the 22nd day of August, 1949, the said petition setting forth that petitioners are residents of the following described territory situated in St. Louis County, Minnesota, to wit: The East One Half of the Southeast Quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), Section twenty-four (24), Township Fifty-seven (57), Range twenty-one (21); and the said petition further setting forth that the above described land contains a resident population of not less than 75 persons, and that said land abuts on the Village of Hibbing, and that no part of said land is more than $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles from said Village of Hibbing, and that said land is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government, and

WHEREAS, the said petition further sets forth that prior to the filing of the said petition, the said above named petitioners, being five of the legal voters of said area, did, on the 18th day of August, 1949, take a true census of the resident population of said area, which census determined that said area had a population of 171, which is in excess of the required number, and the said five legal voters having taken and signed their oath of office as Census Takers, on the said 17th day of August, 1949, and prior to the taking of said census, and the original of said census as taken being attached to said petition filed herein, and showing therein that said foregoing census was duly taken and said five legal voters duly certifying to the same on the 22nd day of August, 1949, and

WHEREAS, the said petitioners do petition the Village Council of the Village of Hibbing, St. Louis County, Minnesota, and the Village Recorder and Clerk thereof, that an election be held on the question of including such above described land within the Village of Hibbing, and that said Village Council of the Village of Hibbing pursuant to law provide for a place and time, not more than 30 days after the filing of the said petition for the holding of said election, and to give at least 16 days posted notice of such election, and to appoint three residents of said territory as judges of the election and to conduct such election pursuant to law, and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 412.041, subd. 5, Minnesota Statutes Annotated, the same being Chapter 119, Sec. 7, Laws of 1949, provide for the holding of such election upon the filing of said petition showing such matters as are set forth in said petition, the said election to be held not more than 30 days after the filing of said petition,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village Council, being the governing body of the Village of Hibbing, St. Louis County, Minnesota, at a duly called and legal meeting thereof, legally held on the 31st day of August, 1949, a quorum being present, that an election on the question of including the said land, described as follows, to wit: The East One Half of the Southeast Quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), Section twenty-four (24), Township fifty-seven (57), Range twenty-one (21), situated in St. Louis County, Minnesota, within the said Village of Hibbing, be held on the 20th day of September, 1949, between the hours of 8 A. M., and 8 P. "On motion of Clerk Grady supported by Trustee Manney, the official canvass submitted by the Election Judges covering the Special Annexation Election held on September 20, 1949, at the Forest Grove Grocery Store, 3705 3rd Avenue West, Hibbing, Minnesota, on the question of whether or not the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24-57-21 shall be annexed to and included within the Village of Hibbing, Minnesota, indicating that 87 votes were cast at said election, and that 87 thereof voted in favor of annexation and none thereof voted against said annexation, was received and placed on file."
