A Proclamation for "Cooperative Month"

WHEREAS, cooperatives have, since early days, played an important role in the economic life of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota now leads all states of the Union in the total number of operating cooperatives and also in the volume of business conducted by cooperatives; and

WHEREAS, the month of October has been designated by the Minnesota Association of Cooperatives as a special time in which to call public attention to the valuable services rendered by the cooperatives of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MORTON H. Youngquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1950, as

"COOPERATIVE MONTH"

In recognition of the many contributions made by cooperatives to the economic well-being of this state.
