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Statement by the State Soil Conservation Committee

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

Be it known that on the 18th day of April, 1950, a petition for the organization of the Chisago Soil Conservation District, signed by more than twenty-five land occupiers was duly filed in the office of the State Soil Conservation Committee;

That on the 5th day of May, 1950, at Lindstrom, public hearing was held after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

That on the 26th day of May, 1950, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory and did define the boundaries thereof;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of the creation of the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the defined boundaries on the 20th day of June, 1950.

That the results of the referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the said referendum were in favor of the creation of the said district; That thereafter on the 14th day of July, 1950, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that the operation of the said district is administratively practicable and feasible; That the boundaries of the said district were defined by the State Soil Conservation Committee as follows:

All of the County of Chisago, Minnesota.

There shall be exempted from the area bounded by the above described boundaries all lands used exclusively for religious, school or burial purposes; all parts and parcels of lands in cities, towns and villages which lands are used principally for residential purposes or for business purposes other than farming; all lands in rural or urban areas of three acres or less; and all lands of five acres or less; and all lands of five acres or less which are used exclusively for woodlot purposes.
