A Proclamation for "KIDS' Day in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, the people of Minnesota are vitally interested in youth and recognize the importance of adult participation in matters pertaining to the welfare of our children; and

WHEREAS, one of the principal tasks facing our nation and our state is the building of youth into useful and honorable citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that we make every effort to keep all children from being prey to day of delinquency and to foster all good and proper endeavors aimed at helping youth to achieve the benefits of the American way of life; and

WHEREAS, through the joint efforts of Edmund International and the National High Five Foundation as represented by our local Kiwanis Clubs, a day has been set aside to focus attention upon the needs and accomplishments of youth at the national, state and community levels; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the day is to provide, wherever possible, assistance in helping underprivileged children enjoy some of the benefits normally accruing to boys and girls in more fortunate circumstances;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LESTER C. TOSSEAU, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate Saturday, September 26, as

"KIDS' DAY IN MINNESOTA"

and do call upon all citizens to support the objectives of the day and to cooperate to the best of their abilities in making the event a success.
