A Proclamation for "Poetry Day in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that a day be set aside for special recognition of the value of poetry in our lives and for honoring the poets, living and dead, who have contributed to our enjoyment, enlightenment and inspiration; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota has reason to be proud of her many able and distinguished poets; and

WHEREAS, the League of Minnesota Poets is sponsoring the observance of Poetry Day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 15, 1950, as

Poetry Day in Minnesota

In tribute to the value of poetry and to the Minnesota poets who have given us our great heritage of poetry.
