

Be it known that on the 29th day of March, 1965, a petition for the inclusion of additional territory within the North St. Louis Soil and Water Conservation District, signed by more than twenty-five land occupiers was duly filed in the office of the State Soil Conservation Committee;

That on the 21st day of April, 1965, in the Embarrass High School, a public hearing was held after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

That on the 3rd day of May, 1965, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare, for including the additional territory within the North St. Louis Soil and Water Conservation District and did define the boundaries of such additional territory;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of inclusion of said territory within the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the said defined boundaries on the 27th day of May, 1965;

That the result of the said referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the said referendum were in favor of the inclusion of said additional territory within the said district;


WHEREAS, Eino Sikrila of Angora, Minnesota, and Jack Starick of Green, Minnesota, the duly appointed supervisors of the Little Fork Soil Conservation District, acting pursuant to the Minnesota Soil Conservation Districts Law, Laws of Minnesota for 1937, Chapter 441, approved April 26, 1937, and Laws of Minnesota 1943, Chapter 274, approved April 2, 1943, have filed in this office an application subscribed and sworn to by each of them before an officer authorized by law to take and certify oaths setting forth: (1) That a petition for the creation of the district was filed with the State Soil Conservation Districts Law, and the proceedings specified in said Act were taken pursuant to such petition, that said application was filed in order to complete the organization of the district as a governmental subdivision and public body, corporate and politic and that the State Committee has appointed them as supervisors; (2) The name and official residence of the district supervisors, together with a certified copy of the appointments evidencing their oath to office; (3) Their term of office; (4) The name which is proposed for the district; and (5) The location and principal office of the supervisors of the district; and

Whereas, a statement by the State Conservation Committee accompanying the above-mentioned application, has been filed in this office, setting forth that a petition for the creation of the Little Fork Soil Conservation District was filed with the State Soil Conservation Committee; that after due notice, a hearing was held, and the committee duly determined that there is need, in the interest of public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory, and that the Committee defined the boundaries thereof; that then, after due notice, a referendum was held on the question of the creation of said district, and the results of said referendum showed a majority of the votes cast to be in favor of the creation of said district; and that thereafter the Committee duly determined practicable and feasible. Said referendum also set forth the boundaries of the district as defined by the State Committee.

Now, therefore, I, Mike Helm, Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby find, after examination of the application and statement referred to above, that the name proposed for said district is not identical with that of any other soil conservation district of the state or so nearly similar as to lead to confusion or uncertainty; and

I, Mike Holm, Secretary of State, do therefore, hereby certify that the Little York Cell Conservation District has been duly organized and constitutes a governmental subdivision of this state and a public body, corporate and politic, vested with all of the powers conferred upon such districts by law.

That the result of the said referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the said referendum were in favor of the inclusion of said additional territory within the said district;




