A Proclamation for "National Beauty Salon Week"

WHEREAS, the entire industry constantly strives to further the interests of all users by active research and an educational program of development of new and better services and products for the beauty salons, and

WHEREAS the hairdressers and cosmetologists of this state contribute greatly to our general economic well-being and success of initiative, and

WHEREAS, beauty work involves the expression of creative ability no less than years of experience and skill, and

WHEREAS, the National Hairdressers & Cosmetologists Association, recognizing these facts, has joined with the men and women of the beauty industry to inaugurate an intensive educational and philanthropic program on behalf of professional beauty care,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER V. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 22-26, 1950, as
