A Proclamation for "Registration of Doctors, Dentists and Veterinarians"

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Act of September 9, 1950, Public Law 779, Eighty-first Congress, which amends section 4 of title 1 of the Selective Service Act of 1948 as amended, the President of the United States has designated Monday, the sixteenth day of October, 1950 for a registration thereunder, and has proclaimed that between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., on that day every male doctor, dentist or veterinarian who:

1. Has not reached his fiftieth birthday,
2. Received from any school, college, university or similar institution of learning one or more of the following degrees, bachelor of medicine, doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, doctor of medical dentistry, doctor of veterinary surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine,
3. Participated as a student in the army specialized training program or any similar program administered by the navy, or was deferred from service during World War II for the purpose of pursuing a course of instruction leading to education in a medical, dental or allied specialist category,
4. Has not had twenty-one months of active duty in the army, the air force, the navy, the marine corps, the coast guard, or the public health service, subsequent to the completion of or release from the program or course of instruction (exclusive of the time spent in postgraduate training),
5. Is not a member of a reserve component, and,

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has called upon the Governor in each of the several States, Territories and Puerto Rico and the appropriate officials of the District of Columbia and of local boards and agencies thereof, authorized under the provisions of the above law, and upon all of the officers and agents of the several States, Territories, Puerto Rico and the District of Columbia to do all acts and services necessary to accomplish an effective and complete registration on the sixteenth day of October, 1950.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Luther W. Youngdahl, Governor of the State of Minnesota, under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the aforesaid law, do hereby call upon all local boards or agencies thereof, all officers and agents of the State of Minnesota and its political subdivisions, to effectively do and perform all acts and services necessary to accomplish effective and complete registration on the aforesaid date.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this 13th day of October, 1950.
