WHEREAS, emphasis on home and family life is one of the distinctive characteristics of this organization; and  
WHEREAS, the activities of the Future Farmers are planned to promote a growing appreciation of the joys and satisfactions of home-making, to emphasize the importance of worthy home membership, to encourage democracy in home and family life, to promote international good will, to foster the development of creative leadership in home and community life, to provide wholesome recreation and to further interest in home economics; and  
WHEREAS, the home, which is the basic foundation in our way of life, is greatly strengthened by the contributions of this outstanding youth program;

Now, therefore, by LUCILLE C. KIRKLAND, Secretary of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning November 12 as

"Future Farmers of America Week"

and urge all citizens to take notice of the many contributions of the Future Farmers of America to our state, and to encourage in every possible way the future growth of this organization.
