Up to the present time, all matters relating to the estates of deceased Pakistani nationals who were resident in the State of Minnesota have been dealt with by the local British Consular Offices and their appointed legal representatives.

This is to advise you that we are now in a position to take over from the British Consular Offices the duties of administering estates of our nationals and we would, therefore, appreciate your notifying this office whenever the death occurs of a Pakistani national in the State of Minnesota or in such cases where a Pakistani national is the beneficiary of an estate.

For your information Messrs. Dunn & Zuckerman of 1475 Broadway, Room 1500, New York 18, Solicitors, have been appointed by us as legal representatives of the beneficiaries.
