PROCLAMATION

Whereas by the enactment of Laws 1949, Chapter 643, the legislature proposed an amendment to Article IX, Section 1 of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota for the approval or rejection of the electors of the state at the election held November 7, 1950, providing that such section when amended shall read as follows:

"Notwithstanding the provisions of Section IA of Article 9 of the constitution, a portion of the proceeds of the occupation tax on the valuation of all ores mined or produced to be paid by every person, co-partnership, company, joint stock company, corporation, or association however or for whatever purpose organized, engaged in the business of mining or producing iron ore or other ores in this state, equal to the proceeds of a tax of one per cent on such valuation levied in the manner provided by law, shall be paid into the veterans compensation fund before the remaining funds derived from the occupation tax are apportioned as provided by Section IA of Article 9 of the constitution.

"This amendment when approved by the people and proclaimed, all as provided by law, shall be effective as of the first day of January, 1949. In the event that the provisions of the preceding sentence shall be held to contravene the constitution of the United States of America, the remaining provisions of this section shall stand as valid and continue in full force and effect.

"This section of the constitution shall expire on December 31, 1958, except as to the proceeds of the occupation taxes theretofore levied and thereafter collected."

And, whereas, it appears from the official canvass of the vote cast at such election held on November 7, 1950, for or against the proposed amendment, made in conformity with the law, that the majority of all electors voting at such election voted for its adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, as Governor of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me and in compliance with law, do hereby publish and proclaim that such proposed amendment of Article IX, Section 1, of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, has been ratified and adopted as prescribed by the Constitution and the laws of the state.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the state to be affixed this 27 day of November, 1950.
