## AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX TO THE VILLAGE OF LONG LAKE, MINNESOTA, CERTAIN TERRITORY ABUTTING ON SAID VILLAGE.

The Village Council of the Village of Long Lake, Ronnepin County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

The following described platted and unplatted land, to-wit:

All that part of the Southwest quarter of Section 54, Township 116 North, Ronge 25 West, described as follows: beginning at a point which is the point of intersection of the line now merking the west corporate limits of the Villege of Long Lake, and the line of the southerly right of way of the Great Northern Reilway, which point is a distance of 330 feet west of the cest line of soid Southwest Quarter, thence in a westerly direction along said right of way a distance of 1103.16 feet, more or less, to a point which is on the west line of the property now owned by William F. Holbrook, and which was dooded to said William F. Holbrook by Carrie L. Holbrook by deed recorded in Book 936 of Deeds, page 517; thence couth parallel to the east line of said Southwest quarter to the center line of County Highway No. 45, now known as the Watertown Road; thence northeasterly along said center line of County Highway No. 45 to the intersection of seid center line with the westerly line of the presently existing corporate limits of the Village of Long Leke; thence north along said west line of the corporate limits of the Village of Long Lake to the point of beginnings

be and the same hereby is declared to be annexed to the Village of Long Lake, Hemopin County, Minnesota.

Upon the filing of a sertified copy of this Ordinance in the office of the County Auditor of Hennepin County, and in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, the ennexation shall be complete and the land shall become part of the Village of Long Lake as offectual as if it had been originally a part of said Village.
