ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX TO THE VILLAGE OF
LONG LAKE, MINNESOTA, CERTAIN TERRITORY
ABUTTING ON SAID VILLAGE.

The Village Council of the Village of Long Lake, Hennepin
County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

The following described platted and unplatted land, to-wit:

All that part of the Southwest quarter of Section
34, Township 118 North, Range 23 West, described as
follows: beginning at a point which is the point of
intersection of the line now marking the west corporate
limits of the Village of Long Lake, and the line of the
southerly right of way of the Great Northern Railway,
which point is a distance of 330 feet west of the east
line of said Southwest quarter, thence in a westerly
direction along said right of way a distance of 1103.16
feet, more or less, to a point which is on the west line
of the property now owned by William F. Holbrook, and
which was deeded to said William F. Holbrook by Carrie
L. Holbrook by deed recorded in Book 936 of Deeds, page
517; thence south parallel to the east line of said
Southwest quarter to the center line of County Highway
No. 45, now known as the Watertown Road; thence north-
easterly along said center line of County Highway No.
45 to the intersection of said center line with the
westerly line of the presently existing corporate limits
of the Village of Long Lake; thence north along said
west line of the corporate limits of the Village of Long
Lake to the point of beginning;

be and the same hereby is declared to be annexed to the Village of Long
Lake, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Upon the filing of a certified copy of this Ordinance in the
office of the County Auditor of Hennepin County, and in the office of the
Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, the annexation shall be
complete and the land shall become part of the Village of Long Lake as
effectual as if it had been originally a part of said Village.
