

An Ordinance extending the boundary of the Village of Jeffers being Ordinance No. 26.

The Village Council of the Village of Jeffers in Cottonwood County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:-

That whereas a majority of the owners of <sup>the platted and</sup> unplatted land herein described and abutting upon the Village of Jeffers, have petitioned the Village Council of said Village to have such land included within the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, Pursuant to the Provisions of Section 707 of the Revised Laws of 1905 as amended by the General Laws of Minnesota for the year 1913, the Village Council of the Village of Jeffers, do ordain that the boundaries of the Village of Jeffers be, and the same are, hereby extended so as to include all of the following lands, to-wit:- All of the land in the South half of the Northwest Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty (20) in Township One hundred seven (107), North of Range Thirty-six (36), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Cottonwood County, Minnesota, not already included within the corporate limits of said Village of Jeffers; and all of said land shall be, and the same is hereby included with the corporate limits of the Village of Jeffers in Cottonwood County, Minnesota.
