Edgerton of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General in the Department of the Attorney General, for the period commencing January 2, 1951, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. He is appointed to represent the State of Minnesota in the matter of recovering abandoned bank deposits and other property pursuant to the provisions of Laws 1943, Chapter 620. I hereby fix his compensation at the sum of Four Thousand Eight Hundred (\$4,800) Dollars per year.

For the purpose of correcting an error therein, the appointment filed is superseded.
