


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 8.06, do hereby, on request of the Director of Social Welfare, constitute and appoint Wm. C. Green, of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General for said Division of Social Welfare, to draft legislation as directed, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. His compensation shall be paid from the appropriation of said division and is hereby fixed at the rate of \$50.00 per day.


