A Proclamation for "Japan Week"

- WHEREAS,** the state bodies and service organizations of our various communities and the departments of our state government recognize the great service rendered to Minnesota by the Junior Chamber of Commerce and
- WHEREAS,** the United States Junior Chamber of Commerce and its affiliated State and local organizations have set aside the week of January 14 to January 21, 1951, to observe the founding of the Junior Chamber of Commerce, and to commemorate such founding by the selection of an outstanding young man in this state as the recipient of the Distinguished Service Award, and
- WHEREAS,** this organization of several thousand Minnesota young men has contributed materially to the betterment of 75 communities in Minnesota and to the state as a whole throughout the year,
- WHEREAS,** this same group of young men is contributing generously of its manpower to the armed forces in the fight for freedom, and the prospects of further calls from the membership of the "Japanes" emphasize the very essence of their movement,

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROBERT W. FULMER, Governor of the state of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 14 to 21, 1951 as**

"Japan Week"

and urge all citizens of our state to join in honoring the Junior Chamber of Commerce for its many contributions to the life of our state.
