A Proclamation for "World Day of Prayer"

- WHEREAS, in the turbulent world of today, we need to come humbly and unitedly to the altar of God in heartfelt prayer as we ask for his blessings upon our efforts to find our way through the darkness; and
- WHEREAS, the United Council of Church Women has designated Friday, February 9, 1951, as World Day of Prayer; and
- WHEREAS, this special day provides an opportunity for people of all religious denominations to join in seeking Divine Help, which will come as unceasing prayer spans the earth;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNG, Governor of the state of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, February 9, 1951 as

"WORLD DAY OF PRAYER"

in Minnesota and ask our citizens to observe the day with services and prayers for guidance in attaining peace, brotherhood and good will for this war-weary world now caught in deadly peril because of human selfishness and greed. Let us participate wholeheartedly in this assurance of our debt to and our reliance on Almighty God.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this Seventeenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred fifty one and of the state, the ninety-third.
