
Satisfactory evidence having been exhibited to me

Bryce James Miller, Esq.

has been appointed British Consul at Minneapolis and St. Paul, Minnesota,  
for that part of the State of Michigan north and west of Lake Michigan; for the States of Minnesota, North Dakota, and South Dakota; and for the State  
of Wisconsin, except the Counties of Columbia, Crawford, Eau Claire, Dodge, Grant, Green, Iowa, Jefferson, Kenosha, Lafayette, Milwaukee, Ojibwa, Racine, Richland, Rock, Sauk,  
Vernon, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha.

I do hereby recognize him as such, and declare him free to exercise and enjoy such  
functions, powers and privileges as are allowed to Consuls by the law of Nations, or  
by the laws of the United States and existing treaty stipulations between the  
Government of Great Britain and the United States.



In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.

I gave at the City of Washington this twentieth ninth day of November, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and fifty, and of the Independence of the United States of America, the one hundred and seventy fifth.
