A Proclamation for "Red Cross Month"

WHEREAS, THE AMERICAN RED CROSS IS AN ENDURING EXPRESSION OF THE SENSITIVITY BY WHICH PEOPLE HAVE GREATLY JOINED TOGETHER TO COPE IMPROVISED HUMAN NEEDS THROUGH COMMON EFFORTS AND
WHEREAS, IN THIS OF PEACE AND WAR, THE AMERICAN RED CROSS HAS ACTIVELY AND UNCEASINGLY GIVEN HUMANITARIAN SUPPORT; AND
WHEREAS, OUR CITIZENS ARE NOW CALLED UPON TO FULLY UTILIZE ITS RESOURCES AND SUPPORT FOR ADVOCATE DEFENSE AND THOSE PLACES OF EMERGENCY PLACES IMPROVING DEMANDS UPON THE AMERICAN RED CROSS; AND
THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN THAT WHILE BLOOD AND BLOOD DONATIONS, FIRST AID TRAINING, WATER SAFETY, ACCIDENT PREVENTION CAMPAIGNS, AND THE CAREGIVING AND RETIREMENT, NURSING SERVICES AND THE MANY OTHER PROGRAMS OF THE AMERICAN RED CROSS, IN HARVEST WITH THE CONSTITUTIONAL CHARTERS,

LET IT THEREFORE BE ADVISED R. KENNEDY, SECRETARY OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, TO IMMEDIATELY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF MARCH, 1951, AS

"RED CROSS MONTH"

IN RECOGNITION OF THE GREAT CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY THE RED CROSS AND UPON ALL CITIZENS TO SUPPORT ITS 1951 RED CROSS FUND CAMPAIGN SO THAT THIS HUMANITARIAN ORGANIZATION MAY BE MAINTAINED AT FULL STRENGTH IN THESE POLITICAL TIMES AND AS MY SYMBOL OF HUMAN SOLIDARITY SPREAD FOR ALL WHO DARE TO ACT IN THIS WEI.
