A Proclamation for "Red Cross Month"

WHEREAS, the American Red Cross is an enduring expression of the tradition by which people have freely joined together to meet imperative human needs through common action; and

WHEREAS, in time of peace and war, the American Red Cross has nobly and unselfishly given humanitarian service; and

WHEREAS, our nation is now called upon to fully utilize its resources and manpower for adequate defense and this phase of emergency places increasing demands upon the American Red Cross; and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for whole blood and blood derivatives, first aid training, water safety, accident prevention campaigns, aid to servicemen and veterans, nursing services and the many other programs of the American Red Cross, in keeping with its Congressional charter;

Now, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT F. WUNDERLICH, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 1951, as

"RED CROSS MONTH"

In recognition of the great contributions made by the Red Cross and urge all citizens to support its 1951 Red Cross Fund campaign so that this humanitarian organization may be maintained at full strength in these critical times and so may continue as a symbol of man's unselfish spirit for all who turn to it in time of need.
