RESOLVED PROPOSITION

A Proclamation For "Save Your Vision Week"

- WHEREAS, unimpaired vision is one of the most precious essentials of good health and vital to the fullest enjoyment and usefulness of life; and
- WHEREAS, the conservation of eye sight requires the continued practice of safety rules by all citizens and vigilance in detecting early symptoms of eye defects, particularly among children; and
- WHEREAS, research shows that seventy-five per cent of all blindness can be prevented by practicing proper rules for the care of the eyes through using industrial safeguards, through proper lighting in home, school and work shops, and through obtaining proper professional care;

AND, WHEREAS, I, EDWIN C. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 14th as

"SAVE YOUR VISION WEEK"

to help create greater awareness of the importance of vision and the necessity of conserving it. I urge all citizens to join in the effort to obtain the conditions, and necessary professional care to aid everyone in the saving of vision.
