WHEREAS, excellent vision is one of the best protection available against death and injury to the public equipment and welfare of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the protection of our sight requires the continued practice of safety rules by all citizens and vigilance in detecting early symptoms of eye disease, particularly early childhood and

WHEREAS, expert advice that early vision screening of all children can be provided by qualified public health nurses for the care of the eyes through visual examination and detection through regular inspection in school and home, and that the cost of this service is minimal; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ERNST W. JORDAN, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 1st, 1951

VISION WEEK, NATIONALLY

To help educate greater awareness of the importance of vision and the responsibility of community life. I urge all citizens to join in the effort to protect our children, and to carry professional care to all persons in the service of vision.

IN FURTHER WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed to the same this second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one.
