A Proclamation for "Crippled Children's Day"

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Society for Crippled Children and Adults is now engaged in the annual Easter Seal campaign to provide funds for its worthy program; and

WHEREAS, through the purchase of Easter Seals, we can invest in the rehabilitation and care of thousands of handicapped boys and girls; and

WHEREAS, with our help, these children will be given renewed hope and happiness;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, the 12th day of March, 1951, as

"CRIPPLED CHILDREN'S DAY"

and I urge the people of Minnesota on this day to buy and use Easter Seals, thereby aiding the Minnesota Society for Crippled Children and Adults to continue its humanitarian work.
