

CERTIFICATION OF ADOPTION OF OPTIONAL PLAN OF VILLAGE GOVERNMENT

To the Secretary of State and County Auditor of the County of Chicago.

I, L. J. Paulay, clerk of the village of Lendleton, do hereby certify that at a special (the general) election held in the village on Dec. 5, 1950, the following question was submitted to the voters of the village:

"Shall Optional Plan A, Modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village?"

I further certify that the affirmative votes cast on the foregoing proposition were 42 and the negative votes were 40 and the question of adoption of Optional Plan A received an affirmative majority of the votes cast on the question.
