A Proclamation for "Cancer Control Month"



- WHEREAS, one of every seven deaths in Minnesota was caused by cameer last year; and
- WHEREAS, it is estimated that one-third of these deaths could have been prevented with early enough disgnosis and proper treatment of surgery or radiation; and
- WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society is carrying on a relentless program of education to inform the public as to early signs of cancer and to further research and treatment of this dread disease; and
- WHEREAS, April has been designated Cencer Control Month by Act of Congress and Presidential Proclamation as a time for concentrating upon the problems of cencer control; and
- WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society is conducting its ennual Cancer Urusade during April to bring our people vital information on cancer, as well as raise funds to continue programs of research, education and service to cancer patients;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIHER W. YOUNGDANL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April, 1951, as

"CANCER CONTROL MONTH"

and urge that all citizens participate in this worthy program by learning all they can about cancer and by supporting the 1951 Cancer Grusade which will be conducted in the state by the Minnesota Division of the American Cancer Society.

IN WITHESS WHEREOF, I have herounto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Winnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this twenty-sixth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one and of the state, the ninety-third.
