& Proclamation for "Fogation Sunday"

WHEREAS, Fogation Sunday, the fifth Sunday after Easter, is traditionally a day set aside to ask God's blessings on the fruits of the earth; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate on this sacred holiday for us to give thought to our responsibilities of stewardship for conservation of the precious soil upon which we depend for the sustenance of life;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HERBERT W. THOMAS, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, April 29, 1951, as

"FOGATION SUNDAY"

and urge that all citizens of Minnesota on Fogation Sunday, April 29, 1951, rededicate themselves to the task of preserving all our natural resources and, particularly, the soil, which is the basis of our entire existence.

BY HERBERT THOMAS, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fifth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one and of the state, the ninety-third.
