A Proclamation for "Good Will Week in Minnesota"

- WHEREAS, the Goodwill Industries is an organization dedicated to aiding people of every race, color and creed; and
- WHEREAS, it provides the handicapped with the opportunity to earn their own living by repairing clothing, furniture and other discarded material so that it may be used again; and
- WHEREAS, during those spring days which are being used in a campaign to "clean up, paint up, and fix up", all citizens can be of great assistance to the program of the Goodwill Industries by giving to it worth-while material which is discarded, but which can be refurbished, repaired, and rebuilt;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEWIS G. BRUNDAGE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 3 through 11, 1951, as

"GOODWILL WEEK IN MINNESOTA"

and urge all good men to help make this special week a success by helping the Goodwill Industries in the State secure the materials needed to carry on this great, humanitarian enterprise.
