A Proclamation for "Child Health Day"

WHEREAS, in accordance with a joint resolution of the Congress, the President of the United States has set aside May 1 as Child Health Day; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the health of our children merits our full attention and concern;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUDWIG W. THUNDERLIL, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the first day of May, 1951, as

"CHILD HEALTH DAY"

so that we may dedicate ourselves to carrying out the objectives of the Midcentury White House Conference on Children and Youth by implementing measures for the full development of the whole child, regardless of race, creed, national origin, through cooperation of all citizens and all voluntary and governmental agencies striving to serve youth.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred fifty-one and of the State, the ninety-third.
