The undersigned who are voters and have resided continuously in the territory hereinafter described, and proposed to be incorporated, for at least two (2) years prior to the date of this petition, hereby petition your Board to call an election and fix a time and place when and where the resident voters of said territory may vote on the proposition of the incorporation of such territory as a Village to be known by the name of Dakota.

The territory proposed to be incorporated as such Village is all situated in the County of Winona, Minnesota, and is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south line of Section seven (7), in Township one hundred five (105), Range four (4), West, where such line intersects the Mississippi River; thence west along said south line of said Section seven (7), and along the south line of Section twelve (12), Township one hundred five (105), Range five (5), West, to a point thirteen hundred and twenty (1320) feet west of the southeast corner of said Section twelve (12); thence at right angles north to the north line of the Southeast quarter (SE¹/₄) of Section one (1), in Township one hundred five (105), North, Range five (5) West; thence east along said north line to the Mississippi River; thence southerly along the Mississippi River to the point of beginning.

This territory consists of land which has been platted into lots and blocks in the manner provided by law and unplatted land which adjoins such platted area and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.

The territory contains 290 acres of land and has 317 actual residents.

WHEREAS, a petition for the incorporation of the area now known as the Village of Dakota, in the County of Winona, Minnesota, has been presented to, carefully examined by and considered by this Board, and

WHEREAS, the said petition conforms to and contains the information required by law, and

WHEREAS there is no qualified newspaper published in the area proposed to be incorporated as such Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Winona County, Minnesota, that:

1. The petition is hereby approved;
2. An election is hereby called to be held on the 19th day of May 1951, between the hours of one P.M. and seven P.M., of said date in the basement of the Methodist Church

within the territory described in the petition for the purpose of enabling the voters of said territory to vote for or against such incorporation;

3. The following residents within said territory are hereby appointed Judges of said Election and to conduct the same in accordance with law, viz: _____

Mrs. William Mattes, Mrs. Howard Bearwald and Clement Iverson

4. Clement Iverson is hereby appointed and directed to post a Notice of Election, with a copy of the petition for incorporation presented to this Board thereto attached, in three public places in the area described in the petition, stating the time and place when and where the voters thereof will vote for or against such incorporation;

5. Ballots shall be prepared bearing the following words, "For Incorporation - yes - No." with a square before each of the last two words, in one of which the voter shall make a cross to express his choice and such ballots shall contain additional information as to the territory and the boundaries thereof upon which the above-titled question of incorporation shall be voted;

6. The Judges of Election upon the completion of the counting of the ballots shall make a signed and certified certificate declaring the time and place of holding the election, and that they have canvassed the ballots cast and the number of votes cast both for and against the proposition, which certificate shall be filed with the County Auditor.

7. The County Auditor shall attach it to the original petition with a copy of the resolution fixing the time and place for the election, the resolution appointing the judges and the original proof of the posting of the election notice and shall file the whole as one document in his office.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner T. J. Fellowski and upon being put to a vote was unanimously adopted.
