ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

The Village Council of the Village of Polay, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the village boundaries of the Village of Polay are hereby extended so as to include the following described parcels of land abutting upon said village, to-wit:

Lot One (1) in Block Four (4), which is of record in the name of Rose Rymor;

Lots Two (2) and Three (3) in Block Four (4), which is of record in the names of Charles E. Holdridge and Charlotte T. Holdridge, his wife, as Joint Tenants and not as Tenants in Common;

Lots Four (4) and Five (5) in Block Four (4), which is of record in the name of Mary Gorecki;

Also that part of Seventh Avenue which lies immediately in front of and abutting upon such lots;

all of said property being in Holdridge Addition to the Village of Polay, according to the plat and survey thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said Benton County;

Passed at a special meeting of the Village Council held on the 11th day of June, 1951.
