- WHEREAS, Minnesota young women have won many awards and honors in this national competition;
- WHEREAS, in preparation for the event in 1951 communities of Minnesota are again holding local beauty pageants at which young ladies will be chosen to represent them in a statewide contest; and
- WHEREAS, the holding of a state-wide competition to select a "Miss Minnesota" will make it possible for our state to be ably represented in the annual national contest at Atlantic City, New Jersey;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 5 through 12, 1951, as

"MISS MINNESOTA WEEK"

thus calling attention to the custom of selecting a most worthy representative of the charm and talent of our daughters of Minnesota.
