


To John Kelley, County Auditor, Rock County, Minnesota:

We, the undersigned common council, of the village of Magnolia, in the county of Rock, and state of Minnesota, do hereby certify that at a duly and legally called special election held in said village on the 24th. day of June 1913, the proposition to make the said village a separate election and assessment district, under Chapter 154 G.L., 1911, was submitted to the voters of said village.

We further certify that the result of the vote on said proposition was as follows: In favor of separating the Village of Magnolia from the Township of Magnolia for election and assessment purposes, 23 votes. Against said proposition 2 votes.
