ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

The Village Council of the Village of Foley, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the village boundaries of the Village of Foley are hereby extended so as to include the following described parcels of land abutting upon said village, to-wit:

(a) Lots Eighteen (18), Nineteen (19) and Twenty (20) in Block Three (3) of Holdridge Addition to the Village of Foley according to the plat and survey thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said Benton County, which is of record in the name of Clara Samra;

(b) Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12) and the South 19.1 Feet of Lot Thirteen (13), of Park Lots Addition adjoining the Village of Foley, in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 25, Township 37, Range Twenty nine, which is of record in the names of Ruth E. and George V. Falberg;

(c) Lots Eight (8) and Nine (9) of Auditor's Subdivision of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 26, Township 37, Range 29, EXCEPTING two tracts previously sold, one being the Northerly 60 Feet of said two lots and the other being the South 123 Feet of said Lot 8 and the South 123 Feet of the East 7 Feet 9 inches of said Lot 9, which is of record in the name of Joseph V. Henry; and Marie Henry, his wife;
