WHEREAS, the Union Label has become an American institution recognized throughout the land as a mark signifying that the goods on which it has been placed were produced under sound American principles and standards; and

WHEREAS, the Union Label identifies a product as the work of skilled craftsmen, who have joined together for the mutual benefit of all workers and the economic well-being of the nation; and

WHEREAS, the American Federation of Labor annually sponsors a nationwide observance of Union Label Week so as to give to the public a better understanding of the Union Label and its importance in our society; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota State Federation of Labor will help carry out the program for this special week;

NOW, WALTER F. DODD, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDALE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of September 2 through 8, 1951, as

"UNION LABEL WEEK"

in grateful recognition of the value of the Union Label in our American way of life.
